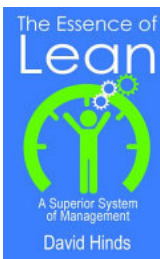

Three Billy Goats Gruff Puppetry Workshop, presented by Bits N' Piece Puppet Theatre


